

WHAT CHANGES HAVE WE MADE?



Maintain social distance as much as possible

- Be close ONLY when ball is live or just before snap
- After the play, 5 seconds to socially distance again
- Have a socially distanced huddle



On the sideline

- Spread out in the team area
- Have plenty of hand sanitizer
- Use soapy water or antiviral wipes on the ball
- Don't share bottles or other items



Safety tips

- Heavy breather? Face away!
- Don't shout at people in front of you
- Avoid touching people unless blocking or tackling them
- Don't hold the ball longer than necessary
- Hands, face, space



Stay away

- If you:
 - have tested positive
 - have COVID symptoms
 - have been told to self-isolate
 - feel particularly vulnerable to COVID this is a personal choice
